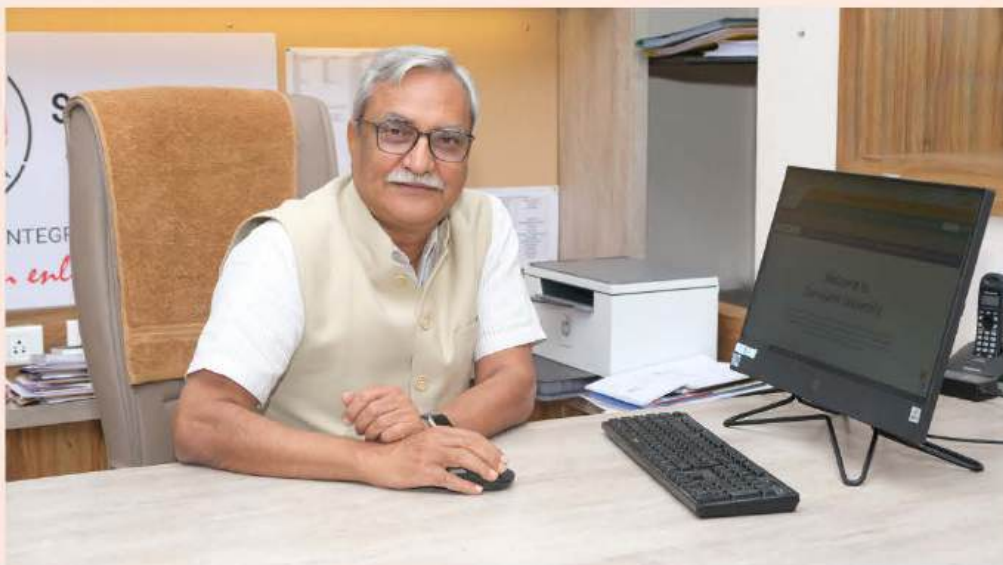

ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY COLLEGE UNDER THE BANNER OF SU



Sarvajani University, India, and Pwani University, Kenya, successfully launched an International Online Seminar Series under the recently signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the two universities. The initiative aims to promote academic collaboration, research exchange, and global learning opportunities.

The first session, held on 26 May 2026, featured a lecture by Dr. Kiran Pandya, Provost, Sarvajani University, on the topic: "Navigating the Philosophical and Methodological Pitfalls of Quantitative Inquiry: From Positivism to Precision – Addressing Critical Issues in Modern Quantitative Research."

The session covered important issues in quantitative research, including aggregation challenges, pooling of data, and model assumptions. A good number of Master's and PhD students from Pwani University attended the seminar, making it a highly engaging and successful start to the lecture series.

From Pwani University, Prof. Nancy Nagowa and Prof. Anne Hilda Ong'ayo shared positive remarks on the MoU and appreciated the collaborative initiative. The session was moderated by Mr. Alex Muthanga.

From Sarvajani University, Dr. Vandana Shah and Dr. Megha Agarwal coordinated the programme successfully.

Both universities expressed their commitment to continuing such collaborative academic activities in the future. The next session in the seminar series is scheduled for 29 May 2026.



A technical lecture on Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAI) was delivered by Dr. Mayuri Mehta to faculty members and students of Nursing, Nutrition, and Public Health at Pwani University, Kenya. The session explored state-of-the-art generative architectures, including GANs, VAEs, Diffusion Models, and Transformer-based Large Language Models, highlighting their capabilities in synthetic data generation, multimodal content creation, and intelligent decision support. Special emphasis was placed on healthcare applications, including medical image analysis, clinical documentation, disease prediction, patient education, and AI-assisted diagnostics. The lecture also discussed implementation challenges, ethical considerations, and future research directions for responsible adoption of GenAI across healthcare and interdisciplinary domains.

As part of this initiative, a delegation of two faculty members and nine students from Jigme Namgyel Engineering College, under the Royal University of Bhutan, visited SCET from 20 to 24 April 2026. The program enabled meaningful interactions with university leadership, faculty members, and students, while also opening new avenues for future collaboration and strengthening cross-cultural understanding and international academic networking.



The TEDx Surat speaker selection process was conducted in three rounds between 29 July 2025 and 14 August 2025 at NJ Seminar Hall, Sarvajani College of Engineering and Technology, from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The process began with Round 1, an initial university-level screening where students presented original ideas before a judging panel. Round 2

featured 14 shortlisted participants, who delivered more structured presentations, and 10 participants advanced to the final round. The final round was judged by TEDx volunteers, who selected the most impactful speakers based on originality, delivery, stage presence, and alignment with TEDx standards. The event was coordinated by Prof. (Dr.) Dipali Kasat, with student coordinators Vansh Chapadia and Aayushi Tamakuwala.

The Women Development Cell, in collaboration with the NSS Unit of Sarvajani College of Engineering and Technology, organized a five-day Civil Defence Training Program from 6th to 10th October 2025 to enhance emergency preparedness and disaster management awareness among students and faculty members. The program provided hands-on training in CPR, fire safety, first aid, rescue operations, and safety protocols through expert-led demonstrations and practical activities. It strengthened students' confidence, leadership, teamwork, and social responsibility while promoting a culture of safety and community service. The initiative also reinforced the institution's and university's commitment to holistic education, skill development, and civic preparedness.





Sarvajanik University's Financial Literacy Club successfully organized FinStart – Igniting Financial Awareness Among Youth on 19 January 2026 at the Auditorium, Commerce Bhavan, KP Campus. CAMPUS AFFAIRS (ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY COLLEGE)

The Department of Computer Engineering, in association with the R&D Cell at SCET, organized an Academia-Industry Meet on 5th February 2026. AIM-2026 brought together developers, engineers, and industry experts to discuss the latest trends, technologies, and challenges in the industry. The event featured expert speaker presentations, engaging panel discussions, valuable networking opportunities, and meaningful knowledge exchange among participants.



The Department of Computer Engineering, under the R&D Cell at SCET, organized an expert talk on 20th April 2026. The expert, Mr. Krapesh Bhatt, provided a comprehensive overview of the modern cybersecurity landscape, emphasizing that security is an ongoing process of risk management rather than a one-time solution. He explained that cyberattacks can have multi-dimensional impacts, including financial loss, operational disruption, regulatory penalties, and reputational damage. The session also highlighted the importance of the People, Process, and Technology (PPT) model and the CIA Triad—Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability—as the foundation of information security.



We are pleased to inform you that the S. R. Luthra Institute of Management, Sarvajani University, is organising the 3rd Student Conference on "Self-Reliant India: Opportunities and Challenges" on January 17, 2026, at the SRLIM Campus. This conference is a great platform for students to present their ideas, research, innovations, and case studies related to India's journey toward self-reliance. Students from all graduate and postgraduate programmes can participate in teams of 2 to 3 members. Papers/articles can be submitted in English, Hindi, or Gujarati. We encourage all interested students to participate and showcase their creative ideas, research skills, and innovative thinking.



SCET's Computer Engineering Department, a constituent of Sarvajani University, successfully hosted the NASA Space Apps Challenge 2025 Surat Edition. The event brought together 500 participants who developed 81 innovative projects based on NASA's 20 global problem statements using open data resources. Participants joined from across India and from countries including Nepal, Germany, Colombia, and the USA, reflecting strong international collaboration. SCET also conducted expert-led bootcamps and orientation sessions to prepare participants, and the hackathon emphasized carbon neutrality and sustainable innovation, with 9 teams selected as Global Nominees for the international level. 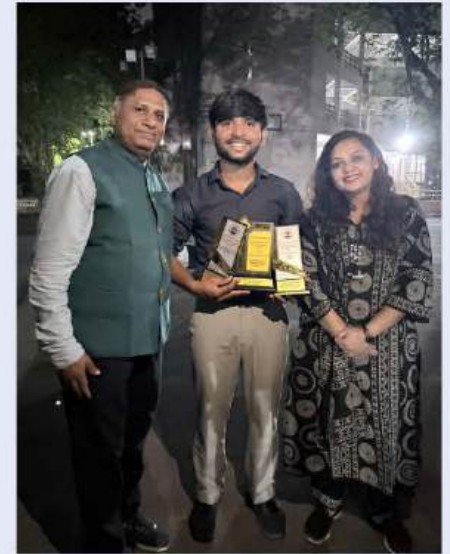

You Won't Believe What Happened Next

Let me tell you how this started. Divya Ma'am announced a book review assignment. I had to pick a book, read it, and present it to the class. Simple enough. The only thing I knew for sure was that I was not picking fiction. I have never been a fiction person. Reading about someone's imaginary world just does not excite me the way real life, real problems, and real growth does.

So I started looking for a self-help book. And then I found it. Or more accurately, I remembered it. The PDF of Dopamine Detox by Thibaut Meurisse had been sitting in my phone since 12th standard. Someone had dropped it in our school group and I had downloaded it, fully planning to read it someday. That someday never came. Until this assignment forced it. And honestly, it turned out to be the most relevant book I could have picked at that point in my life.

Let me ask you something. Has it ever happened that the book is right in front of you, you know *kal exam hai*, but somehow you are still scrolling reels? If yes, congratulations. You have experienced procrastination. And I was not just familiar with that feeling. I was living it.

The book starts by fixing a myth most of us carry. Dopamine is not the "feel good" chemical. It is actually linked to motivation, to the drive to seek something. Back when humans were hunting and surviving, dopamine pushed them to find food, take risks, keep going. It was actually useful then.

Today? That same brain chemical fires up for a notification sound. A reel that autoplays. A "you won't believe what happened next" thumbnail. We have basically hacked our own motivation system and pointed it at completely useless things. And then we wonder why sitting down to actually study feels impossible.

When you are constantly overstimulated, normal tasks start feeling boring. Your brain is used to a dopamine hit every thirty seconds. A textbook just cannot compete with that.

The solution the author talks about is a dopamine detox. Not some extreme "throw your phone in a river" thing. Just reduce unnecessary stimulation for a while. Let your brain recalibrate. Give it a chance to find value in things that actually matter.

I actually tried it. Before reading this book, my Instagram screen time was around two hours a day. I deleted the app for a few days. It went to zero minutes.

I am not saying the book magically made me productive overnight. I still had to build a routine, plan my days, figure out what actually needed my attention. But something shifted in how aware I was. I started noticing when I was reaching for my phone out of pure boredom versus when I actually needed it. That awareness alone felt like something.

Now here's what I said during my presentation and I'll say it again because I genuinely believe it.

A lot of my classmates reviewed books on financial literacy, habits, entrepreneurship. Great books. Important topics. But I feel like we're skipping a step. Because if procrastination is the problem, if we can't sit down and focus for even 30 minutes then what's the point of knowing everything about investing or building a business? That knowledge is going to sit in our heads the same way that PDF sat in my phone. Downloaded. Never opened.

This book talks about the root problem. And I think that matters more than people give it credit for.

One honest thing I will say is that the author does repeat himself, especially around routines and the detox process. You start feeling like you have read a certain idea before. But the core message is strong enough that it does not really bother you after a point.

The question that stayed with me from the entire book is a simple one. "What are you addicted to?" I knew my answer immediately. Reels. No hesitation.

And I think that is where it starts. Just being honest with yourself about what is actually eating your time and attention. Most of us already know. We just do not want to say it out loud.

Dopamine Detox ended up being more than just an assignment I had to submit. It was a reminder that sometimes the biggest distraction is not around us. It is the habits we have quietly built without even noticing. If you are someone who keeps saying *kal se pakka*, this one is worth your time. It is short, it is honest, and there is a good chance it will make you look at your screen time and feel some type of way.

Which, honestly, is exactly the point.

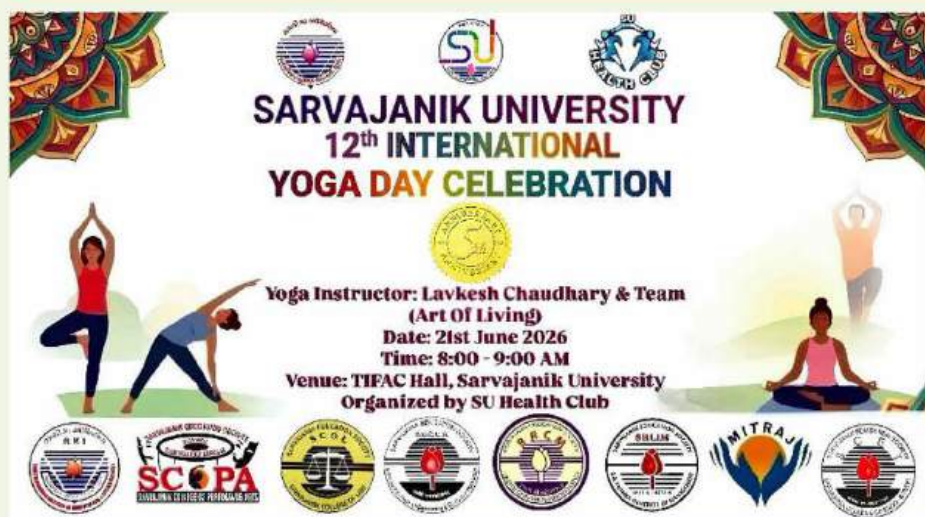
How to Write Thesis – Academic Research Guidance Program
