OBJECTIVE

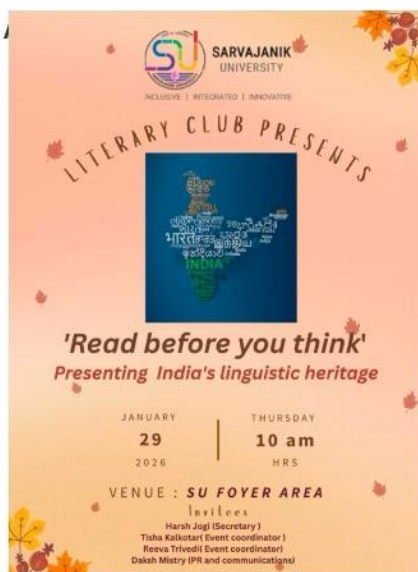
- **Promote Multilingualism:** Celebrating India's linguistic heritage by highlighting diverse regional languages and scripts.
