Day 1 – Skills, AI & Career Growth

Mr. Prashant Bhardwaj delivered an engaging mentorship session focusing on career planning, technology trends, and professional development. Through practical examples and real-world experiences, he emphasized adaptability, continuous learning, and problem-solving as the most valuable skills for future professionals.

Students also learned effective ways to prepare for internships and placements, understand industry expectations, and leverage AI responsibly without compromising creativity or critical thinking.

Day 2 – Professional Growth & Industry Insights

Mr. Pranav Goswami conducted an interactive mentorship session centered around career development, industry exposure, and workplace readiness. Through an open discussion, he shared practical experiences from the consulting industry and addressed students' questions related to career planning, communication skills, networking, and professional growth.

He emphasized that success depends not only on technical expertise but also on adaptability, confidence, collaboration, and a willingness to continuously improve. His guidance motivated students to develop a professional mindset and proactively prepare for future career opportunities.

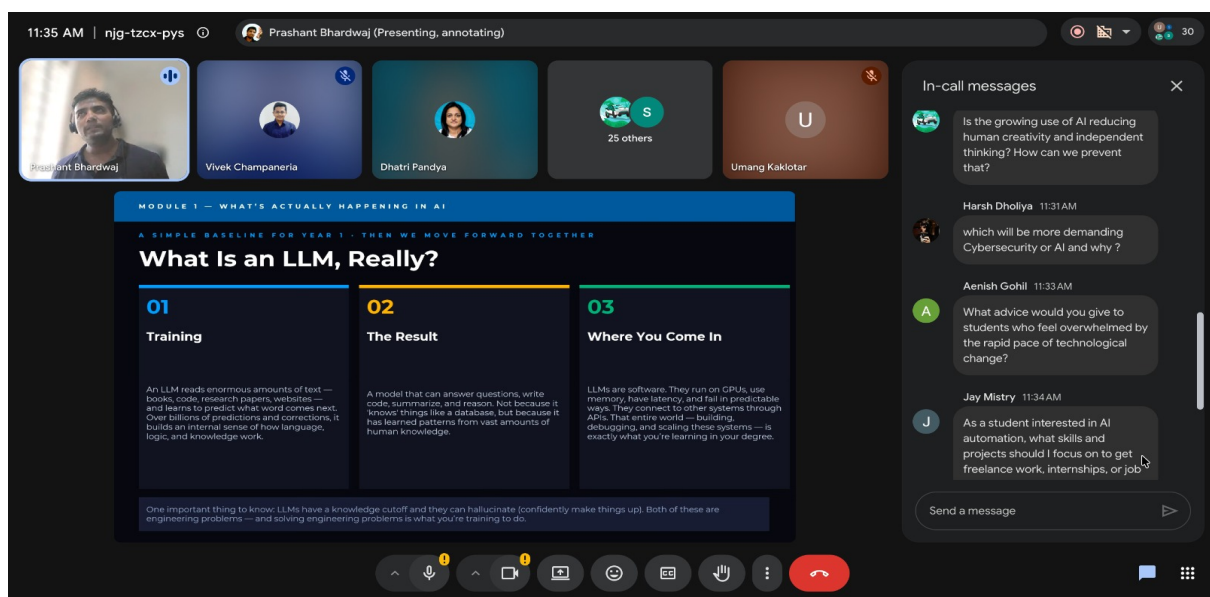
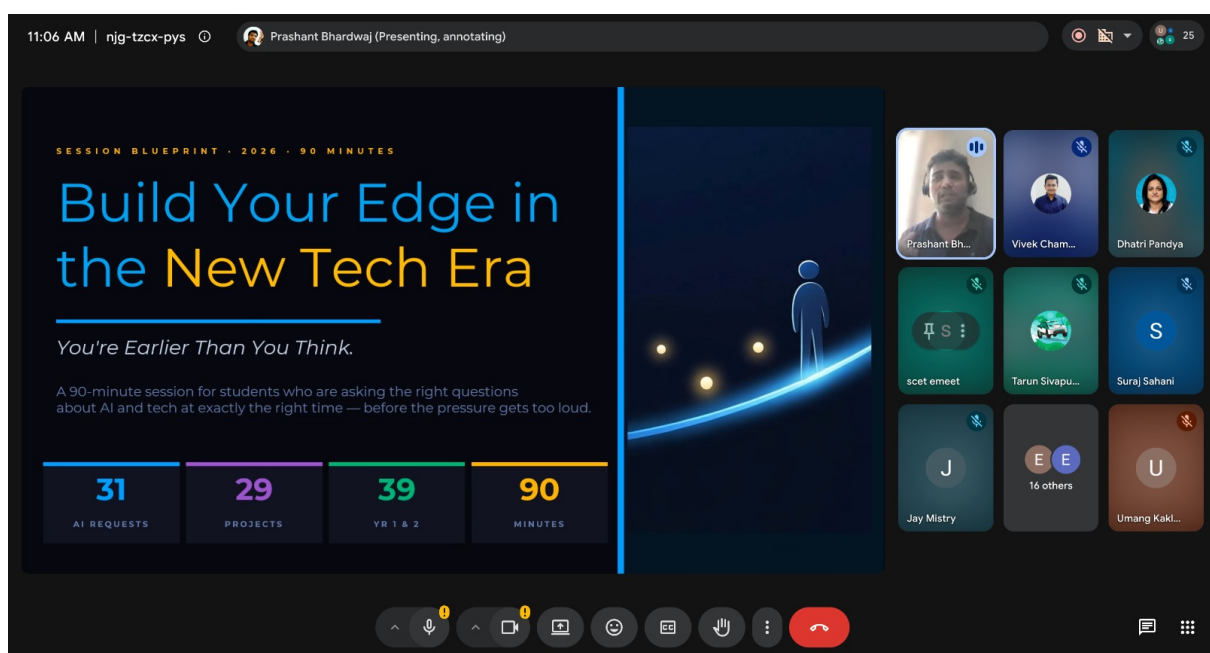
One of the highlights of the session was an extensive interactive discussion where students raised questions about AI, cybersecurity, freelancing opportunities, future career trends, and

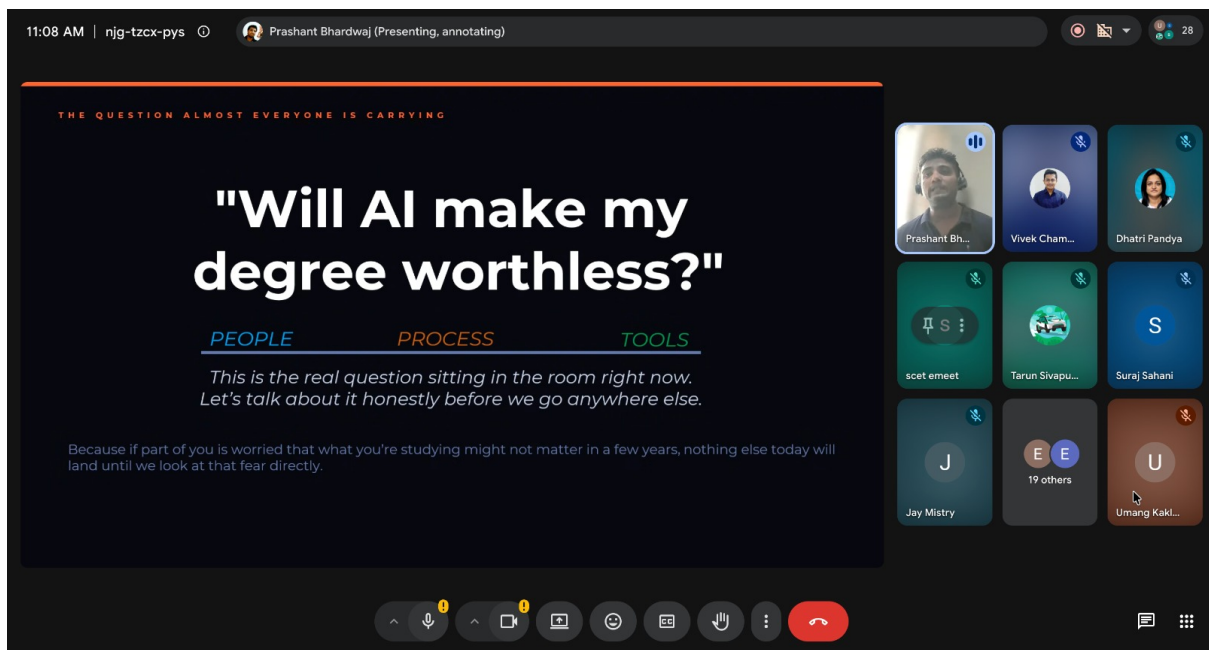
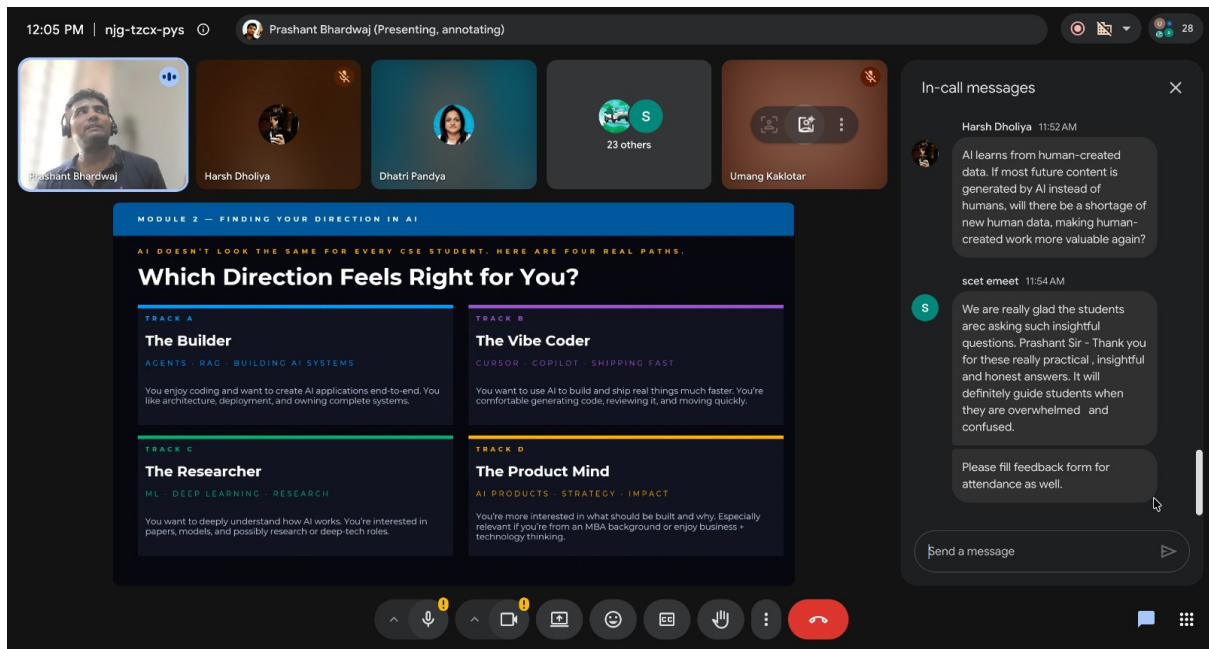
interview preparation. Mr. Bhardwaj answered each query with practical examples drawn from his professional experience.

The prompt guided students to understand a company's business model, competitors, technology initiatives, current challenges, interview strategy, and smart questions to ask recruiters, helping them prepare more effectively for placements.

6. If you had to hire a fresher with no experience, what qualities would make you choose them over hundreds of other applicants?

Day 2 – 9th June 2026

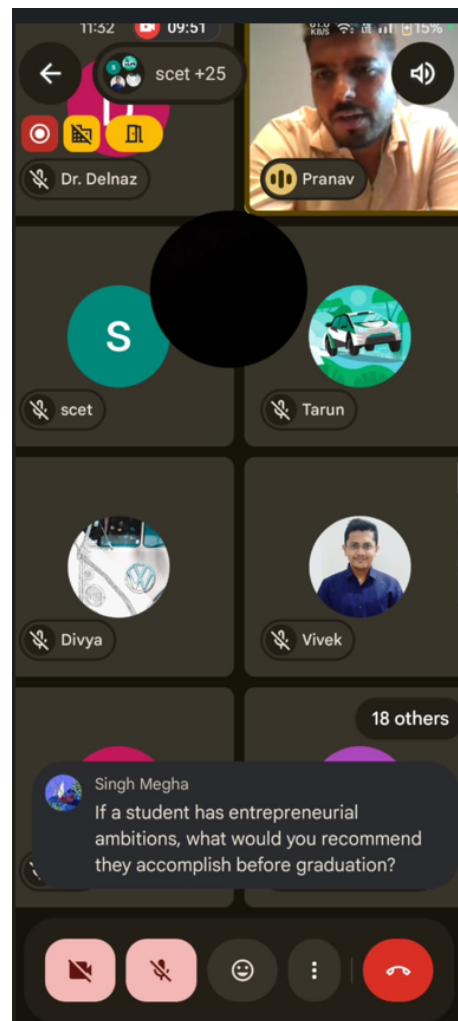
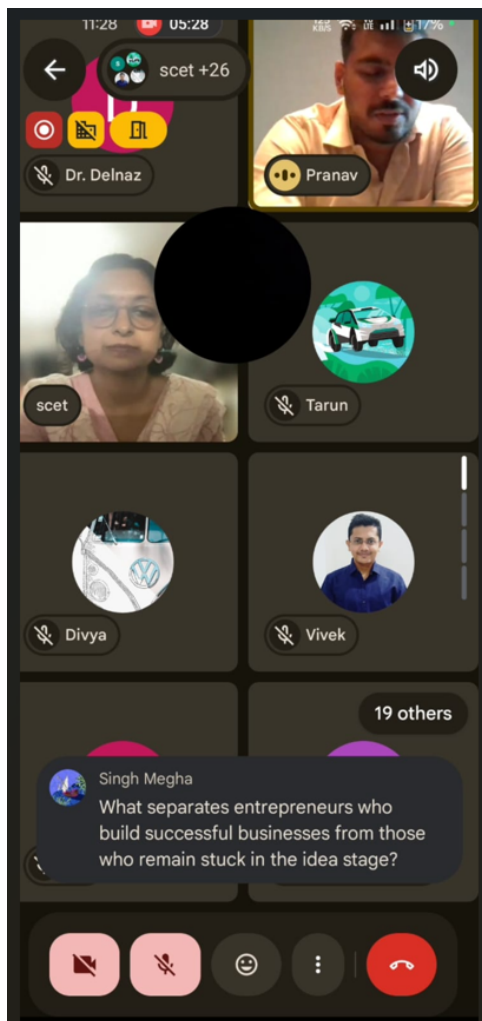

Major Questions Asked – Day 2

1. What separates entrepreneurs who build successful businesses from those who remain stuck in the idea stage?
2. If a student has entrepreneurial ambitions, what would you recommend they accomplish before graduation?
3. I want to become a game developer in the future. Would you recommend first working in a company to gain industry experience, or should I focus on building my own games independently from the beginning?
4. How should students prepare for placements from the first year, second year, third year, and final year?
5. What are the most important skills employers look for in fresh graduates beyond academic performance?
6. How can students effectively build their professional network and personal brand while they are still in college?
