Attendance

Highlights

Day 1: 19th February 2025

Opening Ceremony: The carnival opened with a lively flash mob performance by student volunteers, who showcased the cultural diversity of various Indian states through traditional attire and unique greeting etiquettes, instantly captivating the audience.



This was followed by a digital lamp-lighting ceremony by notable dignitaries, faculty, and students. The event kicked off with a formal ceremony, where the distinguished guests addressed the gathering:





Shri Bharat Shah, the President of Sarvajanic University and Chairman of Sarvajanic Education Society, officially inaugurated the carnival. DJ Show: The most anticipated DJ show wrapped up the first day, leaving attendees with lasting memories.
