Beyond research, you have embraced the future by participating in initiatives for competency building like the “AI for All” Conclave to stay at the forefront of pedagogical technology.

Institutional Progress and Quality Benchmarks:

Sarvajanik University has completed only four years of its existence, yet this has been a year of consolidation and quality enhancement. In alignment with the National Education Policy 2020, we have shifted our focus from inputs to measurable outcomes and societal impact.

Quality remains one of the most serious challenges in higher education. We remain conscious of this reality and have therefore, adopted system-driven approaches, which focus on quality adherence and enhancement. We continuously adapt our curriculum and introduce innovative programmes to address the changing needs of the industry and challenges faced by the society. Integration of research and teaching is strongly encouraged here, at the Sarvajanik University.

Quality Enhancing Measures:

- Academic and Administrative Audits were conducted across constituent colleges, with findings reviewed by the Academic Council, Board of Management
- 



and Governing body, encouraging structured self-introspection and continuous development.

- The University successfully completed a Ph.D. audit this year, emphasising rigor and compliance in doctoral processes.
- A 100% compliance with UGC norms was ensured across academic and administrative domains.
- One of the University laboratories received the accreditation from the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL).

New Programmes and Courses:

Curriculum structures across disciplines were aligned with NEP 2020, supporting flexibility, multidisciplinary learning, and academic continuity.

- New academic programmes and courses were introduced, including postgraduate diplomas in Human Resource Management and Finance and Banking Services, addressing emerging industry demands.
- University commenced LLM with specialisations in Corporate & Commercial Law and Cyber & Security Law.
- Faculty of Science commenced Apprenticeship Embedded MSc programme in Clinical Embryology in collaboration with leading professionals in the field.

Research Ecosystem:


The University has established a Research Development Cell, led by the Dean, Research. Academic growth is supported by a strong research ecosystem, and during the year the University made conscious efforts through strategic investments in this direction.

- The University incurred a total research expenditure of Rs. 61.41 Lakh, for a range of research activities, reflecting sustained institutional commitment.
- I have already mentioned earlier and I feel proud to repeat that Faculty members contributed 95+ publications in Scopus/Web of Science indexed journals.
- Sarvajanik University has a strong research infrastructure, and it was strengthened through the purchase of Databases and Statistical Packages. (IEEE and SAGE journal databases, Turnitin plagiarism detection software, and SPSS statistical analysis software), in the past year.

Conference / FDP / Training Programmes:

At Sarvajanik University, we strategically integrate conferences, seminars, and FDPs to create a dynamic learning ecosystem. The result of this is an academic community consistently ahead of the curve.

Conferences and seminars act as vital bridges between the campus and the global professional community:



- International Profile: Institutes like MITRAJ IDPT have been consistently hosting international academic conferences, which enhance the university's academic profile and expose students to global standards.
- Institutional Dialogue: The SU Samvaad initiative is aimed at promoting leadership skills and constructive communication, creating a “connect”, between students, faculty, and the community, at large.
- National Representation: Students frequently represent the university at high-level forums, such as the National Environmental Youth Parliament, building networks with national leaders and peers.
- Jivan Sanidhya: Jivan Sanidhya stands as a landmark initiative organized in collaboration with the SRK Knowledge Foundation (SRKKF).

Inspired by the vision of Shri Govind Dholakia, this weekly lecture series—held every Monday—features incisive discourses on the autobiographies and biographies of eminent personalities from India and around the world.

These discourses have explored the lives of icons like Leo Tolstoy, Charlie Chaplin, and Vincent Van Gogh, alongside Indian luminaries such as Mahatma Gandhi, Kavi Narmad, Srinivasa Ramanujan, Ratan Tata, and Lata Mangeshkar.

Key Achievements in Excellence:

- Rankings: Our institutions have achieved high score in GSIRF Ranking: Luthra Institute of Management, and Sarvajanic College of Engineering and Technology achieved 5 Stars, also MITRAJ IDPT, Sarvajanic College of Law, and Shri Ram Krishna Institute achieved 4 stars.
- Compliance: We have ensured 100% compliance with UGC norms.
- Infrastructure: We have inaugurated the new MITRAJ IDPT building, with infrastructure facilities conducive to learning and development.
- Innovation: The University secured a ₹1.6 crore grant from the Student Startup and Innovations Policy (SSIP), Government of Gujarat to support our student-led startup ecosystem.

University has several other achievements about, which we feel proud. S. R. Luthra Institute of Management, is honoured with the Southern Gujarat Chambers of Commerce and Industry (SGCCI) Golden Jubilee Mahavir Synthesis Award for Outstanding Institute of Education in April 2025, reflecting excellence in management education and institutional impact.

MITRAJ IDPT has been ranked first, academically at the national level, for the seventh consecutive year.

IEEE-SCET Student Branch won the “ Best Student Branch Award” of India Council out of more than 300 University branches of India.



Global Impact and Proud Moments:

Our university has emerged as a centre of international leadership. MITRAJ IDPT earned a perfect 100/100 score from the Council of Architecture and secured ₹2.5 crore in the European Union funding as a coordinator for international research.

We also celebrate the individual achievements of our students:

International Athletics: Mr. Mohammed Vania won Silver and Bronze at the 2025 Deaflympics in Tokyo, the first athlete from Gujarat to do so.

National Championships: Ms. Kalyani Saxena secured multiple Gold Medals at the All-India Inter-University Aquatics Championships.

Global Innovation: Our students received a NASA award and angel investment for a patented “Anti-Sleep Detector Device”.

Our student Vidhi Pandit, secured the winning entry in the National-Level Lounge Liftoff Challenge, organised by Kyoorius Designyatra conducted for the Bengaluru Airport Lounge.

The Indian Knowledge System: Bhartiya Gyan Parampara:

A distinctive component of the National Education Policy 2020 is the Indian Knowledge System (IKS), aimed at the holistic and value-based development of students. At Sarvajanic University, we have sought to understand its core Darshan (philosophy) and implement it.

We have moved beyond foundational courses to introduce discipline-specific IKS in Chemistry, Environmental Sciences, and Computer Science, enabling contextual learning across domains. I am pleased to share that some of our curricula are compiled by the Commissionerate of Higher Education, Government of Gujarat. Because this knowledge-transfer demands an innovative pedagogy, we emphasise experiential and activity-based learning to ensure that our graduates are ethically grounded and connected to their heritage.

Governance and Transparency:


At Sarvajanic University, effective governance, guided by ethics and transparency, is an integral part of the system.


Digital Accountability- Over 35,000 grade sheets and 10,000+ certificates were uploaded on the National Academic Depository through the ABC-NAD platform, ensuring transparency and long-term academic access.

Structured Self-Introspection - Regular Academic and Administrative Audits are conducted across constituent colleges, with findings reviewed by the Governing Body and Academic Council to ensure continuous improvement.

Regulatory Alignment- As mentioned earlier, Sarvajanic University maintains a focus on 100% compliance with UGC norms and aligns with the National Education Policy 2020, ensuring that the institution meets national standards for quality and flexibility.

Doctoral Programme Audit- A comprehensive audit of the Ph.D. programme was carried out, this year, to reinforce academic rigour and compliance in doctoral processes.





Merit based Progression, I already mentioned in my talk about the faculty promotions under the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS). These are handled through interview-based evaluations to ensure merit-based and transparent career growth.

A University Recruitment Portal is under development to ensure transparency in recruitment process.

Co-curricular Activities:

At Sarvajanic University, we firmly believe that education transcends beyond classrooms and laboratories. True learning happens through engagement, leadership, service, creativity and teamwork.

During the past year, students actively participated in a wide range of co-curricular and extracurricular activities, including:

- Cultural, literary, and performing arts events, showcasing creativity, expression, and cultural awareness Sports and fitness activities, with students achieving recognition at university, state, and national levels
- Academic competitions, seminars, quizzes, elocution contests, and innovation challenges, fostering confidence and critical thinking
- Industrial visits, study tours, fieldwork, internships, and experiential learning programmes, bridging theory with real-world application

These activities contribute towards the holistic development of students.

Outreach Activities:


Social responsibility remains a defining pillar of Sarvajanic University's ethos.

- Students actively engage in community outreach, social awareness programmes, cleanliness drives, health initiatives, environmental activities and civic engagement, reinforcing values of empathy, citizenship, and service through the National Service Scheme (NSS),
- Active participation of students in the National Cadet Corps, commonly known as NCC, effectively contributes towards instilling discipline, leadership, teamwork, and a spirit of nationalism, preparing students for responsible roles, both within and beyond professional life.

These initiatives reflect our belief that graduates being conferred the degrees today are socially sensitive, ethically grounded and community-oriented, beyond being professionally qualified.

Charge to the Graduates:

Today, 2,114 students receive degrees across 53 programmes, and 53 Gold Medals are conferred for academic excellence. I congratulate all the students conferred with gold medal.

DR. RAKESH MOHAN JOSHI

Prof. Rakesh Mohan Joshi is a distinguished academician, eminent author, and renowned expert in International Trade and Management. He currently serves as the **Vice Chancellor** of the **Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT)**. Earlier, he was the Director of the Indian Institute of Plantation Management, Bengaluru, and has been a Professor at IIFT, New Delhi since 2000, specialising in International Trade, International Business, and International Marketing.

He has an outstanding academic record and has received advanced education and training from Harvard Business School, IIFT, Gujarat Agricultural University, Anand, Rajasthan University, Jaipur, and the National Dairy Research Institute, Karnal. He is a recipient of the IIFT Gold Medal and was conferred the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Award (2022) by the Indian Economic Association for his lifetime contribution to economic research and policy.

Prof. Joshi is the author of widely acclaimed books, International Marketing and International Business, published by Oxford University Press, and has served as the Editor of the prestigious journal Foreign Trade Review. His case studies have received international recognition from London Business School and Oxford University.

He has led several impactful research and consultancy projects sponsored by governments and multilateral organisations such as the World Bank, ADB, UNCTAD, and APO, and has extensive international exposure across Asia, Europe, Africa, and North America.

Prof. Joshi has also played a significant role in national education policy and regulation, serving as Chairman of key UGC and BIS committees, including the development of IS 19000:2022 on Online Consumer Reviews. Highly regarded for his scholarship and engaging pedagogy, he is a sought-after speaker and mentor in academic, policy, and professional forums in India and abroad.

**SPEECH OF
DR. RAKESH MOHAN JOSHI**


Honourable Justice,
Honourable President of the University,
Distinguished members of the governing body, faculty, staff, parents, and my
dear graduating students—the Convocation Class of 2026.

It is a privilege to be present at this solemn and celebratory occasion. I extend my respectful greetings to the distinguished dignitaries on the dais and to all those who have contributed, directly or indirectly, to the success of our graduates. I especially acknowledge parents, family members, teachers, and mentors whose unwavering support and guidance have enabled the students to reach this important milestone. Dear graduates, today marks your transition from the structured and nurturing environment of classrooms to the demanding realities of professional life. Within academic spaces, mistakes are considered part of the learning process. However, in the professional world, performance, accountability, and continuous learning become paramount. This transition is challenging, but it is also transformative.

I am deeply honoured to be associated with this prestigious institution administered by the Sardar Education Society. With an illustrious and uninterrupted legacy of over 130 years, the institution stands as a testament to philanthropy, academic commitment, and societal contribution. It is particularly commendable that the University has embraced digital innovation—evident in the efficient, secure, and seamless digital conferment of degrees to more than 2,100 graduates. This reflects a progressive vision aligned with global best practices.

The term *convocation* originates from the Latin word *convocare*, meaning “to call together.” Historically, convocations signified assemblies of scholars and leaders, and over centuries, they evolved into formal academic traditions symbolising the conferment of knowledge, responsibility, and ethical duty. I consider it a privilege to be part of this academic tradition today.





Allow me to briefly reflect on the significance of Surat, the city that hosts this esteemed institution. Surat is an ancient city with a rich historical legacy as a centre of trade, enterprise, and innovation. From being the headquarters of the British East India Company in the seventeenth century to becoming one of India's fastest-growing urban economies today, Surat exemplifies resilience and entrepreneurial spirit.


Presently, Surat contributes significantly to India's economic growth, recording a GDP growth rate of approximately 9.2%, far exceeding global averages. SPEECH OF
JUSTICE RAVIKUMAR R. TRIPATHI

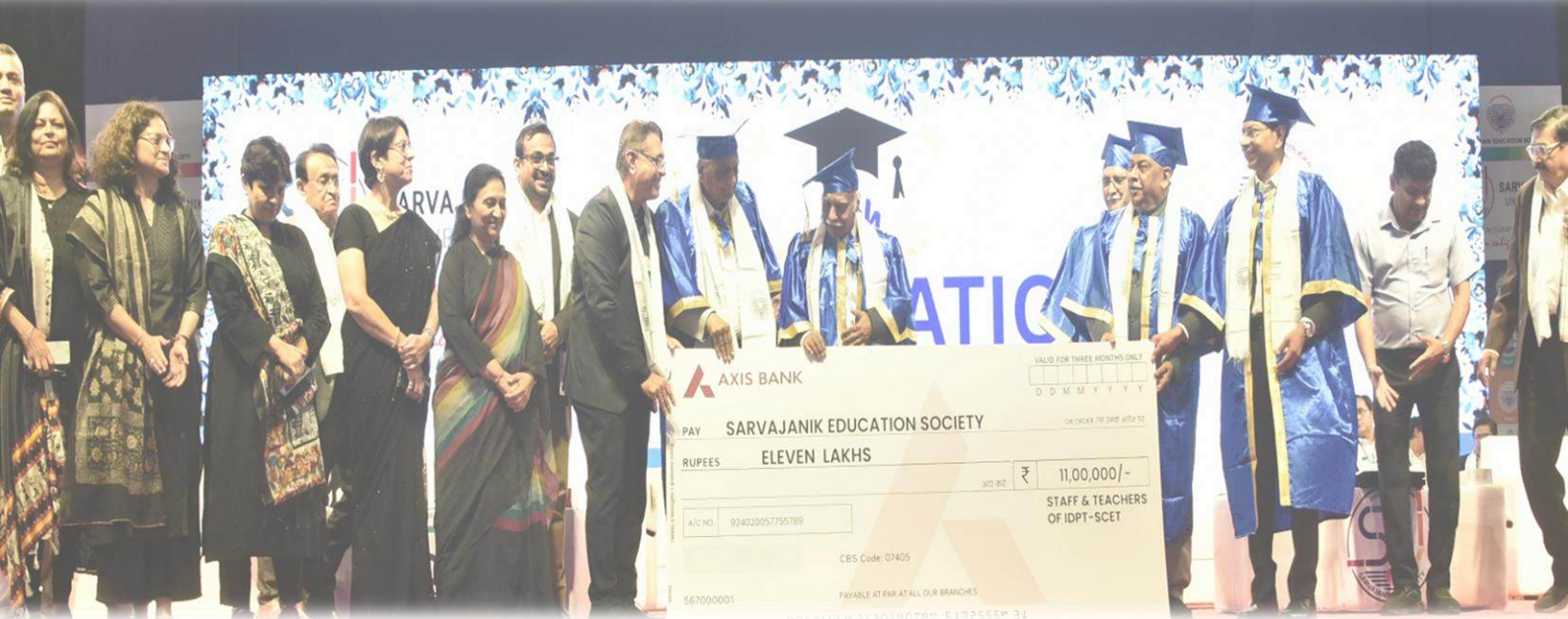
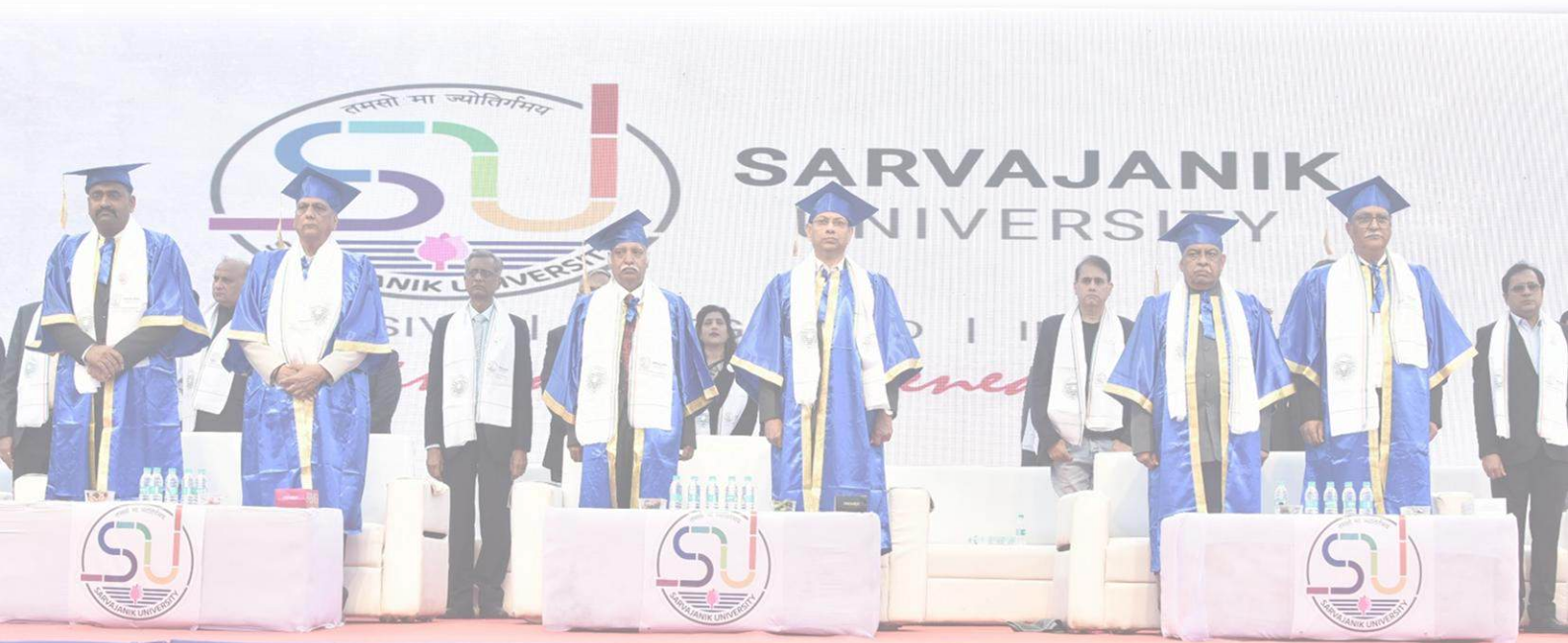

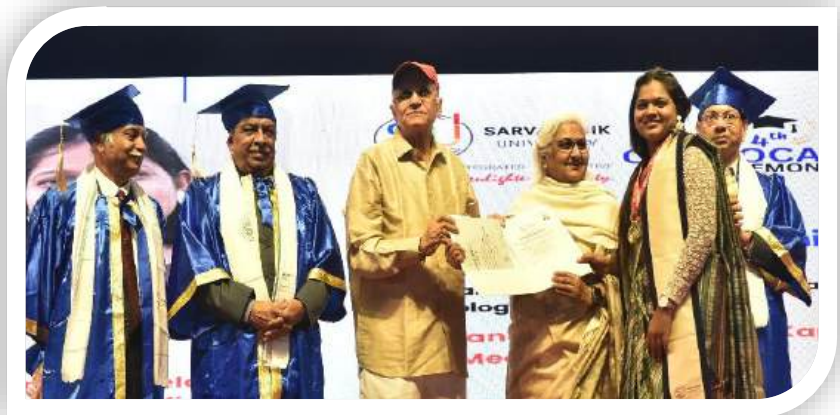
